


## Deactivate colorway

To deactivate any of the catalog colorways, if you have the required privileges, view the colorway you want, then select **Deactivate** from the Actions menu, the following window appears:

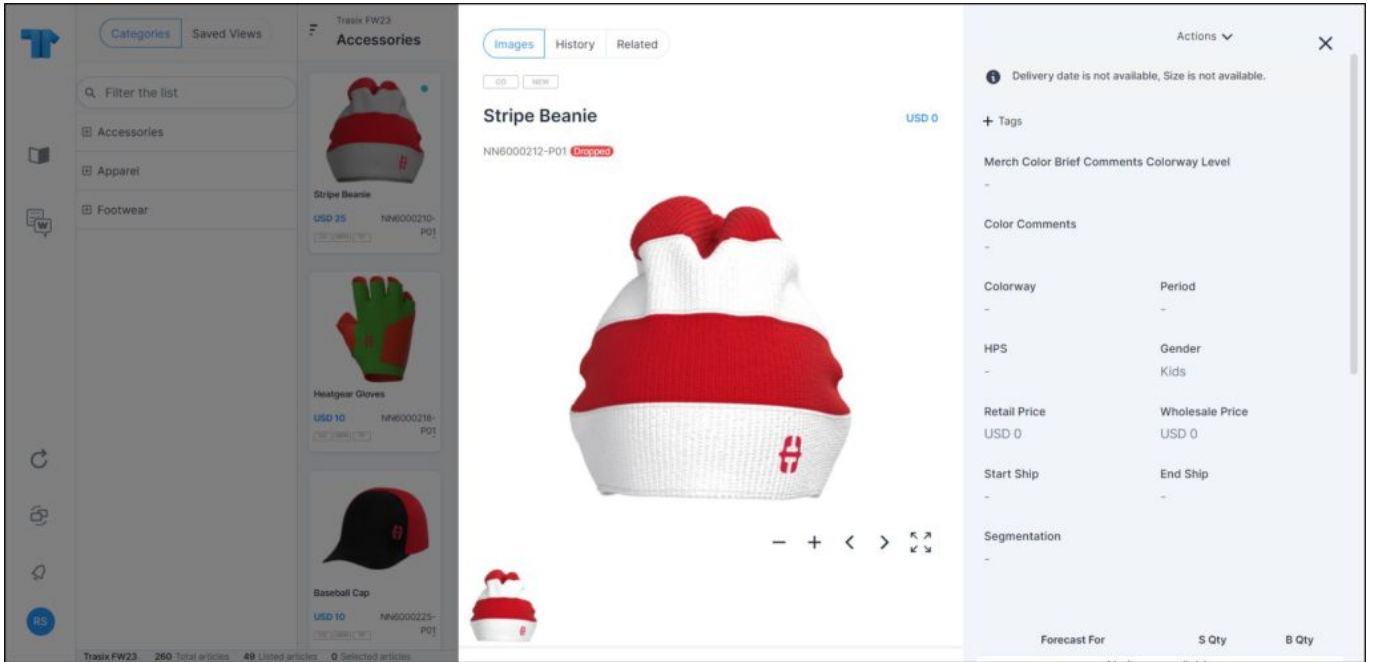

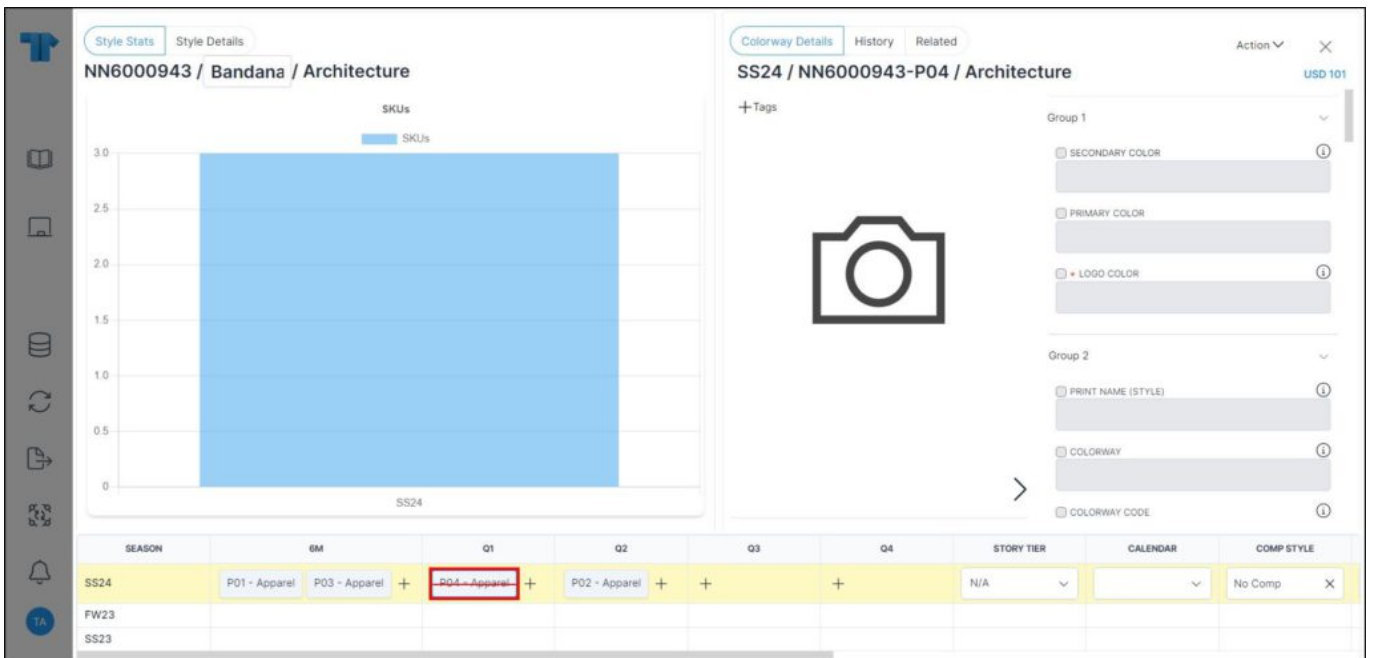
Select the drop reason then click **Deactivate**. Drop reasons are configured at the seller level. The selected colorway is deactivated.

You can also select more than one colorway, then click **Deactivate**.

Depending on the layout, the colorway can be marked as **Dropped** as shown in the below example:



Or the deleted colorway is marked with a red horizontal line as shown in the below example:



All attributes are deactivated and cannot be updated. You can activate the colorway as mentioned in the following section.

**Note:**

- For child catalogs, you cannot select the drop reason as it is cascaded from the master catalogs.
