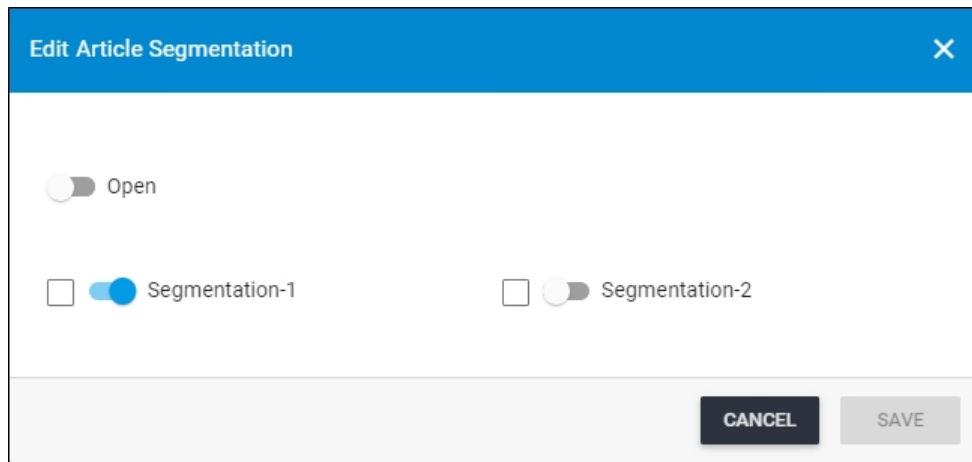


Update article segmentation

To update the segmentation(s) for a single article, follow these steps:

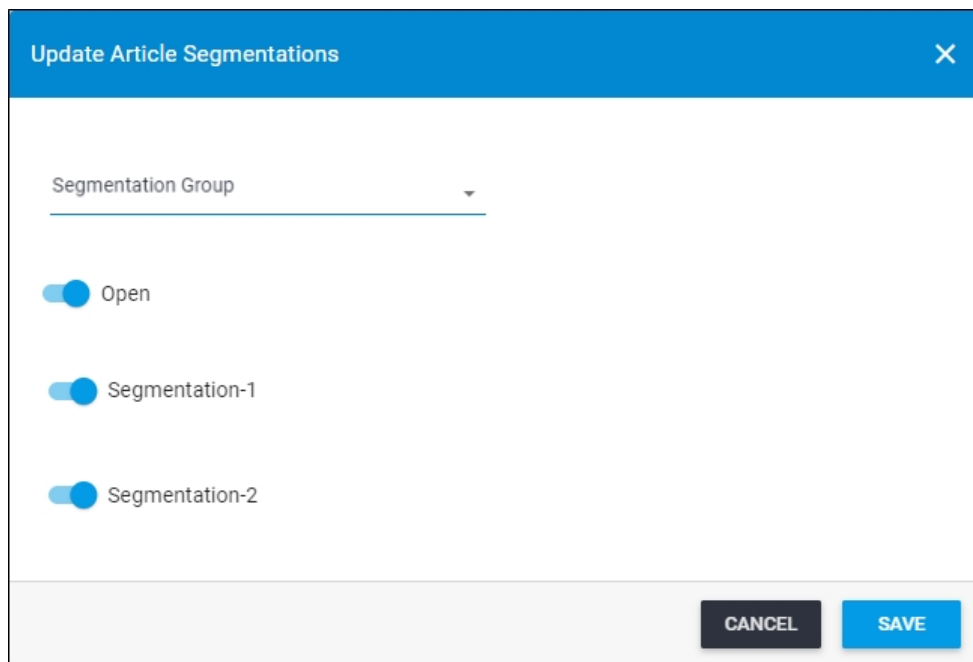
1. Select “Edit Record” from the Actions menu next to the article you want, the following window appears:

4. Click the checkbox next to the segmentation you want to update. Unchecked checkboxes will remain unchanged,
5. Click the slider button next to the segmentation you want to assign to the article, the selected segmentation will be marked with “Yes”, while the other segmentations will be marked with “No”,
6. Click **Save**, a progress window is displayed and segmentations are updated.

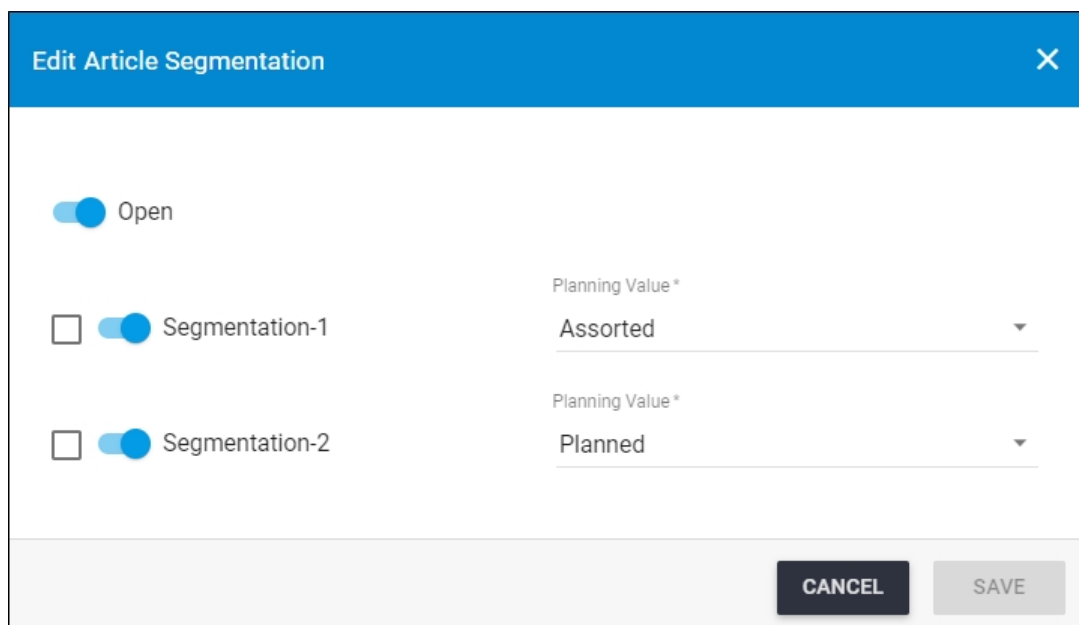
- If a segmentation group is added to the selected catalog, the window appears as shown below:
