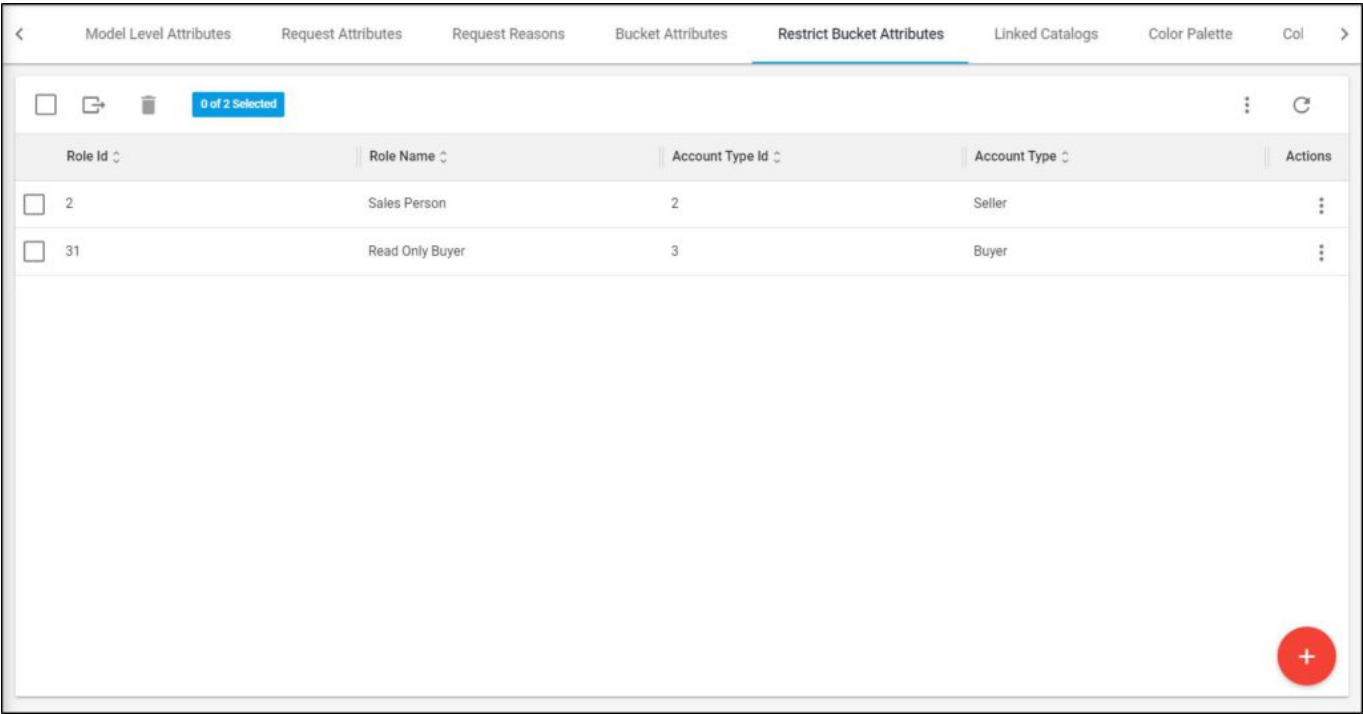


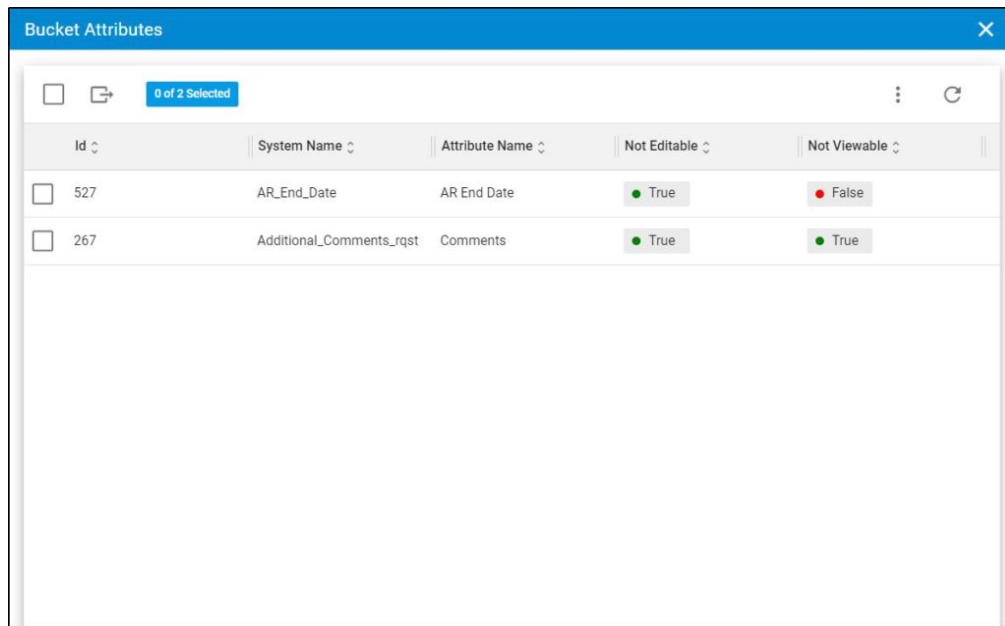
Restrict bucket attributes

Through this tab, you can restrict bucket level attributes for a specific role and specify whether you want to allow this role users to view or edit bucket attributes. Go to **Restrict bucket attributes** tab, the following page appears:
