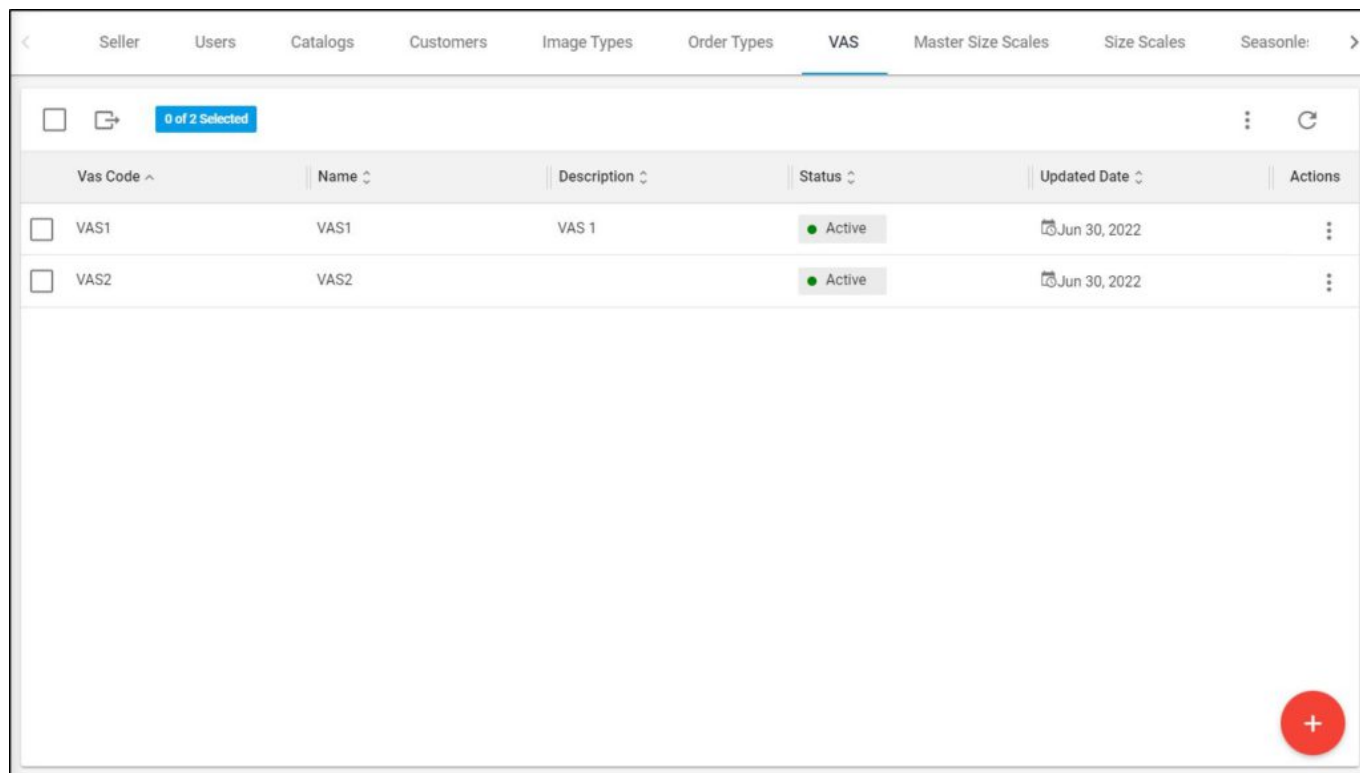


VAS
