



Add article blocking attribute

Add Article Blocking Attribute

To add an attribute, follow these steps:



1. Click , the following window appears:

7. Click **Confirm** to add the attribute and close the window.
8. Click **Save** to add the attribute and close the window, or **Save and New** to add it and open a new window. The attribute is added to the list.
