



Edit individual articles

To update an article, follow these steps:

1. Select “Edit Record” from the Actions menu next to the article you want to update, or

view the article then click , the following window appears:

2. Update any of the displayed information,
3. Click **Save**, a message appears on the page informing you that the record is updated successfully.

Notes:

- The sequence in which attributes are displayed is specified at the catalog level. This is managed by the Trasix Support team.

- Values for attributes that are set as model level attributes for the catalog cannot be updated in the above process. For more information, refer to “[Edit model attributes](#)”.
- If the article is for an inherited catalog and the retail window is set for the master catalog, the window appears as shown below:
